MFN businesses include:

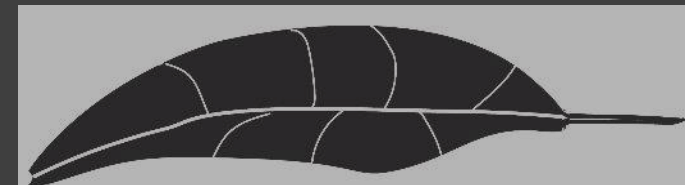
- Muskoday Gas Bar & Store, will transfer to MEDA

- COVID Business Support Program



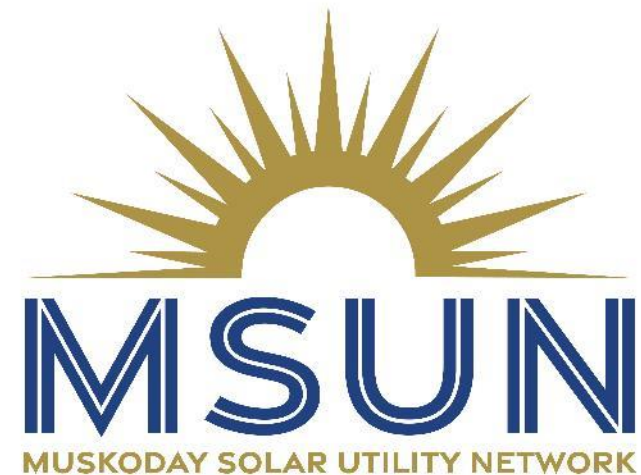
NEW PROJECT UPDATE

Covid business support (2022-23)

- Just completed our initial intake and depending on budget may have another intake later in the year.
- We received 21 applications compared to 7 last year.
- We divided 30,000 between 16 applicants with maximum of 2500, and most received 1500.
