We are pleased to announce the launch of the new Voyent Alert! notification service for the Muskoday First Nation

Voyent Alert! is a multipurpose notification service that will be used to communicate important information to our residents.

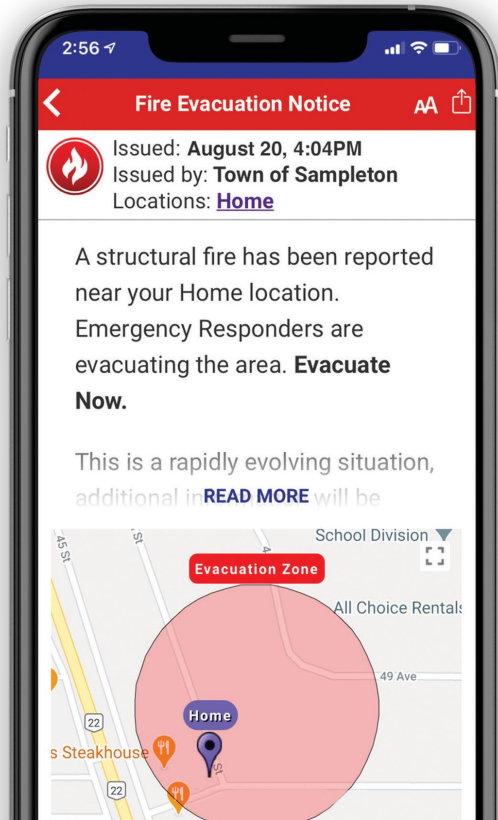
Notifications will be sent for critical events like fire, flood and extreme weather, as well as day-to-day communications such as road advisories, boil water advisories, and utility outages and public safety notices etc.

App registration and troubleshooting guide:

Downloading the app:

1. Have them open the app store
2. Search for Voyent Alert

3. Select download/install.

4. Once the app has downloaded, they will need to open the app and register.
5. Enter their address/town name/ or use the button "Use my current location".
6. When the map loads, they will get to see their location pin, they can tap on their pin and name it "Home, Work, School" whatever they would like for the relevant address.

If the location pin is in the wrong place, have them tap on the pin, and drag it to the correct land location (Sometimes Google Maps has the wrong address, the pin only needs to be in the correct spot on the map, the address doesn't matter)

7. Once the pin is in the correct place, & named correctly, tap Next.
8. They will then get to see the MD of Lesser Slave River account along with the logo and welcome message, read through, tap Next.

If they wish to receive notifications for other communities, they can put secondary pins in other communities, after registering successfully

9. Terms of use, they want to select both check boxes.

If a checkbox is left blank, the system will not allow them to proceed

10. Follow the prompts on the screen, Enter their First and Last name

11. Notification Permission: Next/Allow

12. They can choose to use Smartlock or not, it's just a layer of security for the app

***If there are active alerts, they are going to see all the alerts as a push notification as well,

13. Select "Send Notification"

they still have to press send notification and tap it before they are fully registered***

14. They will then get a push notification at the top of the screen, once they tap on it, they will be successfully registered.

3-Bar menu in app:

1. Home: This will give them a run down of all the features in the app for and how to use them.
2. Notifications: This will show Active and Ended alerts
3. My Locations: This is where the location pins are located and where they can add additional pins. (Home, Work, School, etc...)
 - a. They can either tap, hold, release their finger on the screen to create a new location pin, or select "Add location" and type in an address they are wanting updated for.
4. My Contacts: Here they can add additional contact method points.
 - a. If they are signed up for the app, but would also like an Email, Text, or Phone call, they can add in those contact points here.
5. My Topics: These are going to be informational alerts that people are allowed to choose if they would like to receive them or not.

*****They can opt out of informational alerts but not critical alerts. No matter what they choose for public topics they will always receive critical alerts*****

6. My Profile: This will be where people can add in their first and last name/adjust it if it has changed. They can also unsubscribe from the service here.
 - a. At the bottom of the screen there is a arrow pointing to the right, if they tap on that arrow they will be given the option to unsubscribe
*****If they decide to unsubscribe, it will remove them from all communities they are a part of, and would have to re-register to any communities they wanted to continue with*****
